### BRIEF BIOGRAPHY – JAMES M. SELTZER, M.D.

James M Seltzer, MD is a Board-certified practicing Allergist/Immunologist in Irvine, California. Graduating *magna cum laude* from the University of Pennsylvania, Dr. Seltzer also obtained his MD degree from the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine. He completed a residency in pediatrics at Children's Hospital of Los Angeles, and a fellowship in Allergy & Immunology at the University of California, School of Medicine. He is a Fellow of The American Academy of Allergy, Asthma, & Immunology (AAAAI), The American College of Allergy, Asthma, & Immunology (ACAAI), and the American Academy of Pediatrics. Dr. Seltzer is Professor of Medicine in the Division of Occupational and Environmental Medicine at the University of California, Irvine School of Medicine (UCI). He is also an Assistant Clinical Professor at the University of California, San Diego School of Medicine and Medical Director of Indoor Hygienic Technologies Corporation, an environmental consulting company.

Currently he serves as the Co-director of the PEHSU (Pediatric Environmental Health Specialty Unit) program, a network of experts in children's environmental health, serving the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's region IX and located at UCI. He is also working with UCI in the conduct of the National Children's Study – UCI was selected as one of the seven vanguard sites in the United States. Dr. Seltzer is presently the chairman of the Indoor Environment Committee of the ACAAI, and has also served as Chairman of the Environmental Control and Air Pollution Committee and the Environmental Medicine Committee of the AAAAI. The AAP recently appointed Dr. Seltzer to its national Executive Council of the Council on Environmental Health.

A consultant to industry and to government, e.g., Indoor Air Quality division of the US Environmental Protection Agency, Dr. Seltzer is a well-known speaker on topics relating to how the environment affects health, including programs sponsored by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. E.P.A.), the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (A.T.S.D.R.), and the National Institute of Environmental Health Sciences (N.I.E.H.S.). Additionally, Dr. Seltzer is the author of numerous publications in his field, covering subjects as diverse as the health effects of mold, active and passive cigarette smoke, air pollutants, and the diagnosis and treatment of asthma, particularly in children.

Areas of expertise: allergy, asthma, immunology, toxicology, pulmonary, human illnesses caused by environmental factors, children's environmental health, indoor and outdoor air quality/pollution, sick

buildings, building science. In addition to his medical practice, Dr. Seltzer has been providing forensic (defense and plaintiff) medical and environmental consulting services for the past 18 years, and has been recognized in court as both an environmental expert and a medical expert.
